

# A

Cut on the solid lines for a spit toe spat and the curved lines for a round toe or extend the top to make a longer spat.

Seam allowance not included.  
fold fabric so that wrong sides are touching.

Lay out your pattern and cut out the two layers.

Do the same with your lining.

Sew B and C to piece A according to cutouts with right sides facing.

Ending up with an outside for the Left and Right foot

and a lining for the Left and Right foot.

Take Left lining and Left outside and place right sides together,

sew along both long sides and the short side of C.

Turn right side out and sew together the final seam by folding the edges under.

Place on shoe and decide on placement of elastic and closures.

Notions: For closures: buttons, frogs, snaps or snap trim... velcro, tie pins or anything else you can think of. How about binder clips?

\*Remember to always make a muslin example first to get the fit right.



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
